

## **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

"Local" means Exhibitors in the Cassowary Coast Regional Council and Hinchinbrook Shire areas except for Horse events.

Competitors in the Ring events must enter immediately when called upon by the Stewards.

The Society will not be responsible for any accident that may happen to any Exhibit at the Show and it shall be a condition of entry that each Exhibitor shall hold the Association blameless and indemnify it against any legal proceedings arising from such accident.

Ring Entries can be made on the day.

Stables to be booked in advance.

Entries to be made on the Entry forms provided by the Society and must be in the hands of the Secretary or stewards by the closing times as per schedule, together with the entry fees, without which no entry will be accepted.

**Please refer to Schedule Sections for entry closing times.**

It is a condition of entry that the Society is not, under any circumstances, to be held responsible for any loss, damage or mis delivery of any livestock or other exhibits at the Society's Show.

**All Farm and Dairy Produce, Horticultural, Vegetable, and Industrial exhibits must be the production of the person exhibiting them.**

The Judge reserves the right to withhold prize if entries not up to standard.

Only dogs which have competed in other classes are eligible to enter to the Championship Class. No Pedigrees shall be inserted in the Catalogue, but owners of Pedigreed animals may post up on their stalls particulars of their animals' pedigree after it has been judged.

Any exhibit which is late in either the Pavilion or Ground is liable to be disqualified and the Entrance Fee forfeited.

**No Exhibit shall be removed from its place before 3.30pm Saturday of the Show without the permission of the Section Stewards.**

Exhibits must be properly ticketed before being received by the Stewards. These tickets will be supplied by the Secretary when entry is made and must bear the number of the Section and Class in which the Exhibit is to be shown.

**Protests:** The sum of \$5.00 shall be lodged with the Secretary by any person entering a protest in connection with the Show.

The onus of proof shall be with the lodger of the protest. All protests shall be decided by the Committee and their decision shall be final. If, in the opinion of the committee, the protest is frivolous, the deposit shall be forfeited.

**ALL protests must be in writing and must be lodged with the Secretary before the close of the day of judging.**

The Judges may award Certificates of Commendation in addition to awards mentioned in the schedule, or may withhold any prize if, in their opinion the exhibit is not of sufficient merit.

**The decision of the Judge shall be FINAL.**

The foregoing regulations and notes as set forth in the Schedule are to be conditions of Competition. Any matter arising not herein provided for, shall be determined by the Committee whose decision shall be final in all cases throughout the Schedule, unless otherwise provided for. The committee reserves the right to substitute trophies or vouchers donated after printing the Schedules in lieu of cash prizes. Supplementary Schedules may be issued at the discretion of the Committee.

No Exhibitors will be allowed in the Pavilion during the classification and judging of exhibits.

The Committee reserves the right to reduce the prize money for any event, or to cancel the event if, in the opinion of the Committee, paucity of entries and/or competitors for such event do not warrant the amount of prize money awarded. The Committee reserves the right to alter this prize Schedule at any time without notice.

Prize money not collected by 30th September 2022 become the property of the Show Society.

Every exhibitor, competitor, member or other person or persons who bring on to the Society's land or land over which the Society exercises any control or authority any wares, merchandises, farm produce, horticultural, vegetable or industrial products or animals of any kind or nature whatsoever for the purpose of exhibit, display, sale or any other purpose whatsoever shall hold the society and its members and officials blameless and of no liability of any loss, damage, destruction or mis delivery whether deliberate or not which may be occasioned to such property. The Show Society does not accept any responsibility for the loss or damage to any article or thing brought on to its land.
